Carrousel of the Nations celebrates 35 years in Downtown Windsor

Windsor, ON — The Multicultural Council of Windsor and Essex County (MCC) today confirmed that the Opening Weekend of Carrousel of the Nations will be held at Riverfront Festival Plaza in downtown Windsor from June 11 - 13, 2010.

The Carrousel will celebrate 35 years in the city centre with numerous activities including a commemorative museum exhibit opening at the Francois Baby House Community Museum on May 9; the introduction of a commemorative cookbook featuring 84 recipes from over 20 regions; and the presentation of world music, food, dance, arts and crafts at its Opening Weekend, June 11 - 13, 2010.
